About the contest...

It is a unique activity of Modern College to felicitate and appreciate the most outstanding student with 'The Best Student Trophy Award' from each wing (Junior, Senior and Post Graduate). It has been done in order to tap the best potential of each student. Over the years, it has been done successfully and we are sure, it would continue to be so. To add up to the benefits of the students, this year onwards we are conducting the whole process online keeping in mind the transparency of the procedure. This will help each student to understand his status in comparison with those of others.

The Best Student Trophy is awarded to the Best Student from Junior Wing, Senior Wing and Post- Graduate Wing. The best student from Junior Wing receives College Trophy and Late Jyotsna Godbole Cash Prize. The best student from Senior Wing receives Damodar Shield and Veer Savarkar Cash Prize. The best student from Post-Graduate Wing receives Late Bansude Trophy.

The selected best student from each wing is honoured by the **'Excellence Trophy'** and a **blazer** by the college.

Any student of Modern college securing marks above 60% in the previous year with minimum 75% attendance is eligible to apply for this contest. A student should have good academic career and active participation in curricular, extra-curricular and sports also. Being a part of the society he/she should be active in social work individually or through any NGO. The Committee considers the valuable contribution in NSS and NCC by giving extra credits.

All activities performed into last two years of current year are taken into consideration for credits. On the basis of merit of credit points, the student is shortlisted for the next round of the contest. (Co-curricular Activity includes competitive examinations, Seminars, Project, Presentations related to academics, subject related competitions etc. and Extra-curricular Activity includes Arts, Vocal, Instrumental related competitions, sports, NSS and NCC or any activity other than academics.)

The process of selecting the Best Student of The Year is as follows:

- The committee invites online applications from the students and scrutinizes them by predefined norms.
- A separate merit list is prepared for each wing and eligible students are shortlisted for an interview which consists of a personal interview and a group discussion.
- List of shortlisted students and the date of personal interview is displayed on the web page of the college.
- Best Student of the Year' is declared only on the basis of his/her performance in the personal interview and group discussion. (The credit points received in the first round are not included in the second round)
- The Best Student Trophy winners are then felicitated in a grand ceremony which is conducted soon after the competition.

बेस्ट स्टुडंट ट्रॉफी डॉ. संजीवनी राहणे



मॉडर्न महाविद्यालयाची आधी विद्यार्थिनी आणि नंतर प्राध्यापक. विद्यार्थिनी असतांना बेस्ट स्टुडंट ट्रॉफीसाठी पहिल्या फेरीमध्ये निवड झाली, पण पुढची फेरी पार करू शकली नाही, त्यामुळे बेस्ट स्टुडंट ट्रॉफी बद्दल खूप कुतूहल होत. बेस्ट स्टुडंट ट्रॉफी समितीमध्ये सभासद म्हणून काम न करता एकदम अध्यक्षपदी नेमणूक झाल्यावर प्रथम आनंद झाला आणि नंतर जबाबदारीची जाणीव झाली. पण एक प्रकारे पती पूर्ण कोरी होती म्हणून एकदम स्वच्छ नजरिया ठेऊन काम समजून घ्यायला मजा आली.



I was a member of Best Student Trophy Committee from 2006-2008. Earlier when Prof. Kulkarni was the Chairperson I was invited as a member of the panel of judges for interviewing best students for three years and this is how I got acquainted with the working culture of this committee. And then from 2009-2013, for 5 years, I got an opportunity to shoulder the responsibility as the Chairperson of the committee. I have indeed immense pleasure to work with the Best Students committee as it gave me the prospect to understand and implement the various processes of selection of the Best All rounder students of Modern College, Shivajinagar from the three wings Junior, Senior and Post Graduate.

Basically, as I belong to Computer Science Department, my first intention was to make utmost use of computers in the process of functioning of the committee to avoid paperwork to a great extent. There were some existing formats already but I started storing the whole information digitally. Our committee finalized many of the formats for various reports of the committee including different notices, individual student's marks as per their various certificates, a summary report for all the students, magazine report as well as assessment sheets of judges after the interview with group discussion and marking criteria. Actually I wished to completely computerize the committee working but due to my other responsibilities it became difficult for me to complete the computerization process.

Dr. Sanjeevani Rahane had introduced group discussion of the shortlisted students in her tenure. So the judges had to interview the candidates and then all the candidates were needed to be called together for a group discussion. For two years, there was a bit of difference of opinion among the judges about whether to consider the marks based on their certificates (short listing marks) in order to finalize the results obtained through the interview process. Some judges were of the opinion that if a student is shy to express himself then even if he is topper of the short listed students, he cannot be considered as the winner. Under the guidance of Vice-Principal Prof. S.R.Chaudhari it was decided that after short listing the students, those marks should not be considered for final results. So those were to be considered only as the qualifying marks. Then

onwards the same procedure is followed till date. I am still working in the judges panel for the last three years.

All the chairpersons have to bear a great responsibility, as they have to deal with the multi-talented students of the college, also they have to take some steps towards efficient working of the committee. Every decision has to be carefully taken after discussing with Principal Sir, Vice-Principals, teachers and committee members, as it affects the students. It was indeed a great opportunity to work as the Chairperson of this prestigious committee which gave me enormous pleasure and also added some great learning experiences which I carry with me today.

I am thankful to our Principal Dr. R.S. Zunjarrao and Vice Principal Prof. S.R.Chaudhari for considering me eligible for this position. I am thankful to all my committee members as well for their support and help extended through out.

We, the Best students of the Modern College are very thankful to Mrs. Paratane and our beloved Principal Dr. R. S. Zunjarrao for giving us a chance to enriche ourselves by attending the sessions.

This year the 8thBhartiyaChatraSansad was organized on the grounds of MIT-WPU from 19 to 21 January 2018. This initiative was launched by the hands of Dr. Vishwanath Karad, UNESCO-INDIA, Chair and founder of MIT-WPU and by his son Mr. Rahul Karad. The youth refrain from entering politics, as the face of politics is maligned by some previous notorious peoples. Along with them two special awards were conferred to women parliamentarians for their commendable job. The inaugural ceremony was followed by talks of the eminent personalities from the government on issues like the "*Beginning of the Trump era, India's stand on it*". The sessions were chaired by the speakers of various states. As there were two sessions, the second session was presided by Mrs. Smriti Irani, Hon,ble Broadcasting and Telecommunication minister. The topic that she was asked to speak about was on the "Role of Pakistan and the perspective of the civilians towards the army of the nation". There was a brief intellectual dialogue between Mr. Tushar Gandhi and Mrs. Smruti Irani on the same.

On the second day, i.e. On 20th January there were very intense sessions to be organized. The peculiarity of the Bhartiya Chatra Sansad is that each session of interest allows 4 student speakers to put their views in front of the masses and the selection of such students is scrutinized. People, youth from all over the nation actively participate in this very arcade. Secondly, at the end of each session there is a question panel forum where in the student leaders could ask questions to the dignitaries related to the session. The second day was marked with burning topic, "TripleTalaq", it was chaired by the famous personalities of the All India Imam association, Mr. Moulana Rizvi, Ms. Shabana, an women's right activist from Lucknow and the famous lady Ms. Shayara Bano the sufferer of the Triple Talaq incident, who petitioned in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the decision of the panel of the judges went rightfully in the favour of Ms. Shayara Bano and made this decision a legendary in the history of India. There was also an announcement of considering the holy Cow as the national animal of India by the chief Imam and this decision was very well acknowledged. It was really an honour to witness the journey of Ms. Shayara Bano to attain such a marvelous feat and to listen to her talk. After this, a session named, "GDP or Gross domestic Happiness (GDH)" was chaired by many notable spiritual gurus like Gaur Gopaldas Swamiji and notable ISCKON spiritualists. This session was a mind awakening one and was really acknowledged by the audience.

The Bhartiya Chatra Sansad platform also performs a novel idea of forming and passing resolutions based on the sessions planned in the event. The resolutions are passed by the active participation of the student leaders and are directly sent to the Loksabha and the Rajyasabha for further considerations.

The third and the final day was marked with the presence of very notable and distinguished dignitaries like the Hon'ble Ex and First lady President of India Mrs. Pratibha Devisingh Patil, Hon'ble veteran leader of the BJP, Dr. Murali Manohar Joshi and the grandson of Mahatma Gandhi, Dr. Rajmohan Gandhi. The session that was to be chaired by them was a very new concept- *"100 years of Satyagraha"*. We were deeply enlightened by the talks of Rajmohan Gandhiji, idealogy behind Satyagraha and its implications in the routine life. The talks by the Ex-President and Dr, Joshi were also enlightening.

The Era of Junior College and NCC:-

The Electronics teachers helped in developing logics and circuits. In my final year all teachers of the Physics Department nourished me well. They helped me in understanding Physics at a deeper level.

The annual camps and various activities there like street-play, sky gazing, cleanliness drive, awareness programs, helped me to search my true self. The Somanath and Aanadwan camp (shramsanskarshibir) gave me an opportunity to meet renowned personalitites and inculcated the value of work. I lived there the, 'Not me but you' slogan of NSS. 
