1. Activities Reflecting the Goals and Objectives of the Institution:

The Vision statement of the institute is 'जानमयोभव', (Dnyanmayo Bhav) meaning 'Be Knowledge Incarnate'. It is inscribed at the top of the logo of the Institute as shown below:



- The initials of the name of the parent institute P.E.S. (Progressive Education Society) are inscribed at the centre of the logo. The name of the parent institute aptly spells out the way to realize its vision by remaining **progressive** in attitude and adopting **modern** means of knowledge.

 Co-curricular activities such as educational tours and visits, various workshops and hands-on training, competitions, skill oriented programmes, etc. for the benefit of the students.

- 5. Examination reforms implemented:
 - 1. Separate Exam control room and strong room have been setup.
 - 2. Equipment like multicopier machine, computer, printer, scanner, intercom, telephone, CCTV camera system and internet facility are installed in exam control room.
 - 3. 'Vruddhi Software 'is used to process examination form, enroll the students, to prepare subject wise summary, make seating arrangements, preparation of results, etc.
 - 4. During examination, students are provided filtered drinking water through water coolers, near the examination halls. Totally 10 water coolers with filters are installed.
 - 5. Two diesel power generators are installed in the college premises. All examination halls are connected to these power generators. This helps to keep the atmosphere in the exam halls remain comfortable.
 - 6. CCTV camera system is installed in exam control room, strong room, passages outside examination halls and in some of the class rooms. This has helped in maintaining discipline during examinations.
 - 7. The rooms, in which CAP work is conducted, in which CCTV camera system is installed.
 - 8. Wheel chair and two elevators are available to physically challenge and medically unfit students and staff concerned with the examination.
 - 9. During the examination, medical assistance whenever required is provided through nearby hospitals. In addition to this, first aid measures are kept available in exam control room, staff room, office and all other departments of the college.
 - 10. College has four portable Public Address Systems. During the entrance examination conducted by the College, these are used for effective communication of instructions to the candidates.
 - 11. College has 'Common Computing Facility', which is equipped for conducting online examinations. IT examinations and few other examinations of computer science department are conducted in online manner.
 - 12. College has purchased mass SMS package for the benefit of students, Staff and Parents. Important and urgent instructions are given to these stake holders through SMS system.
 - 13. Only Vice-Principals are appointed as internal senior supervisors of University examination. They can handle the responsibility better, due to their other administrative experienced.
 - 14. Additional authority viz. Chairman, Examination Committee of the College, looks after overall conduct of the examination and maintenance of discipline during examination.

- Some departments have organized power point presentation competition and weekly seminars for inculcating teaching skills among the post graduate students.
- Special sessions on IPR, Cyber crime, scientific writing, Interview techniques, Personality development, Communication skills, etc are organized.
- Activities like Hobby exhibitions, Poster exhibitions; Street plays on socially relevant issues, etc are conducted.
- Book exhibitions and sale are organized in collaboration with Ramkrishna Math, Pune.
- To promote reading habit in students and staff, main library arranges display of books of general topics on every Saturday.
- Twenty one skill development workshops are autonomously designed and conducted.
- Educational quality enhancement workshops were arranged.
- Industry-academia meet were arranged.
- Self defense training for girl students was conducted.
- Special coaching camps and workshops are organized for students participating in Sports and Cultural activities.
- A physical education department of our college organizes 'Physical Fitness Test' for the first year graduate students.
- Film club activity is carried out to supplement traditional class room teaching learning method.
- To promote research activity, student's research projects exhibitions and in-house e-research journal publication is done.
- Due to encouragement given to the students for doing research, many students have presented their research papers in National and International Conferences.

Part C Outcomes achived by the end of the year

- College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) status from UGC was successfully obtained in the year 2010.
- New U.G. courses, P.G. courses and P.G. Research Centers recognized by University of Pune are started.
