Ghorpadewadi is located about 60 km from Pune district. Excessive use of chemical fertilizers in recent past has created problems of water contamination, less crop yield, soil salinity and low fertility. So to address this issue we organized awareness program for farmers of Ghorpadewadi. Through this program they tried to inform farmers about the benefits of biofertilizers over chemical fertilizers, importance of soil testing at regular intervals, crop rotation and use of affordable modern technology to reduce the efforts and time in agricultural work. They also informed them about institutions where soil testing and all other such tests are carried out.
